Student Leader Spotlight: Nick¹

For this month's Apologist Corner, rather than introducing you to an argument, allow me to introduce you to a student apologist: Nick. He recently won Ratio Christi's highest student honor, the *Legatus Christi* (Ambassador of Christ) Award.

WHAT IS YOUR GRADE AND MAJOR?

"I am a Senior at IUPUI, majoring in Philosophy."

WHAT IS YOUR ROLE AT RATIO CHRISTI?

"I am the new President of our RC Chapter at IUPUI."

HOW HAVE YOU SEEN GOD AT WORK ON THE IUPUI CAMPUS?

"What Ratio Christi does best is facilitate dialogue between seekers and people of faith who have dedicated much of their life to addressing the concerns of a great variety of seekers in the spirit of 1 Peter 3:15. I am one such person of faith and I have received many opportunities that would have otherwise not presented themselves to preach Christ, His atoning death, and His resurrection. When relationships are established through Ratio Christi it's in a context where those involved are seeking answers to the most existential and intimate questions people can ask, and in that spirit, you can go far toward the kingdom with an unbeliever who is willing to consider the possibility that Christ is Lord."

ANYTHING ELSE?

"Christians who have a heart towards ministry should not be dismayed by our current cultural milieu which may appear indifferent or even hostile towards the cross. There are many young students who are seeking answers to very high-minded questions and who are thirsting for a peace that only Christ can supply. To paraphrase some words from the great Augustine of Hippo, there are a great many heirs to the kingdom among our enemies, they simply don't know whence their inheritance comes just yet."
