Meet One of Our Partners

Meet our Every Home for Christ ministry partner in Benin, Avla Sunday. Avla grew up in a home that worshiped idols and was not allowed to speak to Christians. One day while visiting



a relative, Avla made a new friend and was invited to a movie at the friend's church. While Avla thought he was going for entertainment, the movie was actually about heaven and hell and followed by a gospel message from the pastor. After listening to the pastor, Alva went up for the alter call and received Jesus.

"They taught me about real salvation and six months later I was baptized. There was a fire in me and I wanted to tell the story of heaven and the hell to all my people. Soon after, God called me into evangelism. Today I can say that Jesus is everything I am and everything I have," Avla shared.

Volunteering together to organize and pack shoes for Africa is a rewarding, 2-hour, team building opportunity for youth and adults. Please

bring the gospel to every school and prison. The Bible verse that encourages him is Ephesians 2:10, "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

Avla asks us to pray for the following:

- Safety and protection for Alva, his wife, Veronique, and their family.
- Divine healing in Veronique from a blood infection that is weakening her immune system.
- Protection over the ministry work being done in Benin, known as the capital of voodoo.
- For the souls who are still in bondage, that their lives be touched when the team proclaims the Gospel.
